The Tolomato Island election of the Board of Directors is over. In unofficial results, Fresh Candidates will fill 3 of 7 positions – the Board was expanded to 7 members to resolve a 3-way tie. Based on 2-minute speeches at the Annual meeting, there is much work to do to find common ground, and heal the division created over the past years. We pray, that all Directors will find a way to work toward consensus on all matters before them.

**Participation** – The election was a tremendous success in regards to increasing participation. Ciphering 2022's voting, there were approximately 85 votes. Ciphering 2023's voting, we had 195 voters (unofficially). Nobody increases participation by over 100%. THAT IS SPECTACULAR!!

That increase is largely about us, the Newsletters, SIG, the Web site, mailings, and personal contact. Those communications motivated owners and ultimately, they participated. Tolomato Island has changed. Going forward, regardless of how owners voted, there will be 100 more sets of eyes watching. That is wonderful.

We assume the other team received primarily directed proxies. Not only did owners vote for the candidates of choice, directed proxies eliminated the ability to manipulate votes.
